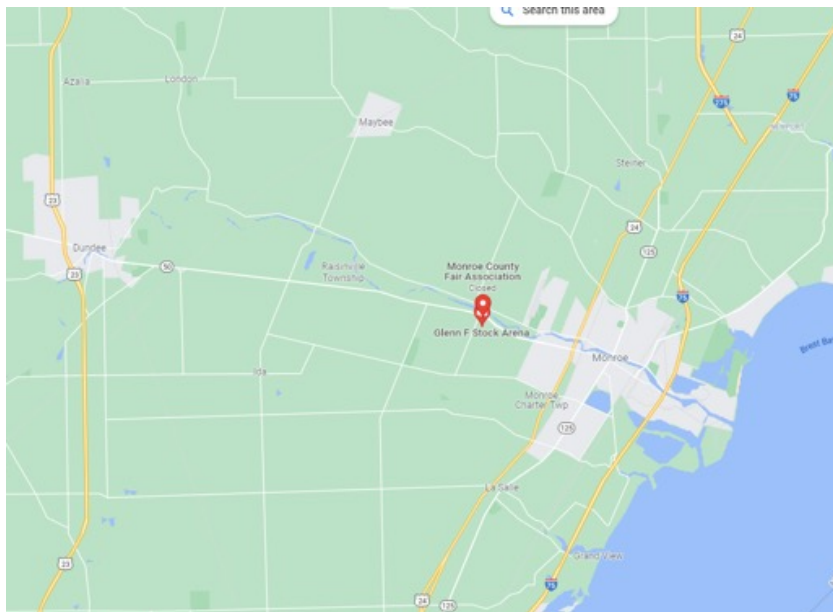
SITE FOR AGILITY/CCA/OBEDIENCE/RALLY/SWEEPSTAKES/CONFORMATION

From U.S. 23 - Take the M-50 exit at Dundee. Take M-50 (also known as South Custer Road) east approximately 15 miles. The fairgrounds will be at the intersection of South Custer and Raisinville roads.

From I-75 North - Exit at LaPlaisance Road, Exit 11. Go west to Dunbar Road. Turn left on Dunbar, going about 7-10 miles to Raisinville Road, where you turn right. The fairgrounds are located 1.5 miles on the corner of Raisinville and M-50.

From I-75 South - Take the I-275 north exit to Telegraph Road (US-24, this will be the first exit). Take Telegraph Road south to M-50. Take M-50 west 3 miles to the fairgrounds.

From I-75 Exit 15 - Take Exit 15 west to Elm Street (approximately 1 mile). Turn right on Elm Street and continue through town approximately 3.5 miles to Raisinville Road. Take a left on Raisinville. The fairgrounds are just over the river on the corner of Raisinville & M-50.

ALL RIGHTS to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote and otherwise exploit this event are vested in the GRCA or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the club. All persons and animals on the Show Grounds at any time while the show is in progress do, by attending this show or participating therein, grant the club the right to photograph, televise, videotape, audiotape, or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent.

FREELANCE PHOTOGRAPHER POLICY AT GRCA NATIONAL SPECIALTIES (GRCA RES 18-27)

Any professional photographers, other than the official event photographers, taking candid photographs or videos at this National Specialty which are intended for sale shall:

1. Be a vendor authorized by the GRCA National host club,
2. Pay a required vendor fee,
3. Wear a GRCA National Press Pass while taking photographs or videos, and
4. NOT take photographs in the designated win photo area or during the GRCA Top Twenty Event.

The GRCA reserves the right to bar any offending photographer from a specific event until its conclusion if the sale of photography is determined by the General and/or Event Chairperson to be the intent of the photographer. Such a violation may lead to a bench hearing by the Event Committee. Personal cameras and cell phone photography are permitted only if there is no intent to sell photos taken at any time during or after the National and are not permitted in the win photo area.

The professional video services and live streaming at this show are governed by an exclusive video contract with the Club. No other commercial video recording, video recording from a tripod, monopod or other supported camera/device, or any video recording or streaming of large parts or whole classes shall be permitted. The contract terms permit individuals to record small

bits of video of their own dogs only, and using handheld devices only (e.g. phone, tablet or small camcorder). Individuals may post recorded videos of their own dogs to social media (Facebook, YouTube, etc). However, during show hours LIVE Broadcast Streaming to social media (e.g., Facebook Live) is not permitted. Submission of an entry form and/or physical presence on the show grounds shall constitute both implied and real consent for both the handler and the dog to be professionally video recorded and streamed live only by the professional video services as contracted by the Club for this show.

All rights to video record and live stream or otherwise exploit this event and/or the persons or animals participating in it, including the names, likenesses and biographical matter of dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the event shall belong solely to the show giving Club and/or the American Kennel Club, Inc. No spectator, participant, owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall make commercial use of any video recordings of any person or animal participating in this event without prior written approval from the Club. This event may not be broadcast to social media (e.g. Facebook Live, etc) without prior written approval from the Club.

GENERAL PHOTOGRAPHY RULES

All first-place winners and major award winners are required to have a photograph taken by the official show photographer.

Requesting a photo to be taken by the official show photographer constitutes a contract between the owner and/or exhibitor and the photographer.

Any first-place winner or major award winner who does not desire a personal copy of the win photo is required to advise the photographer of this fact at the time the photo is taken. Otherwise, the owner and/or exhibitor will receive a copy of the photo and will be held financially responsible for it.

If at all possible, photographs are expected to be taken on the day the award is won.

Any photo bill not paid within 60 days of the event is considered delinquent. GRCA will do everything in their power to collect any unpaid invoices after that point.

The GRCA reserves the right to bar any offending photographer from a specific event until its conclusion if the sale of photography is determined by the General and/or Event Chairman to be the intent of the photographer. Such a violation may lead to a bench hearing by the Event Committee. Personal cameras and cell phone photography are permitted only if there is no intent to sell photos taken at any time during or after the National and are not permitted in the win photo area.

HOTEL INFORMATION

ALL MOTELS AND HOTELS ARE UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE EVENT COMMITTEE.

- Although there is no designated host hotel, exhibitors must treat all hotels and motels with respect.
- Please bring plastic sheeting to place under crates. Please do not leave your dog uncrated in the hotel room when you are gone. Please bring your own sheet to cover the bed. Please remove the bedspread and place it in the closet or drawer.
- If an accident occurs, please clean it up promptly and report its location to the hotel for further cleanup.
- Clean up after your dog and place waste in plastic bags before depositing it in trash containers.
- GRCA National Specialties have an excellent reputation for being considerate and courteous with regard to hotel properties. We expect that the 2022 National will continue this tradition.

GENERAL INFORMATION

GENERAL RULES ON FAIRGROUNDS

1. The grounds will be open 24 hours a day during the National Specialty. Security will be on-site during the evening hours throughout the National.
2. Exhibitor and visitor parking will be in designated areas only. No cones are to be used in these parking areas. (see site map for these areas) No parking in roadways or next to buildings except where designated. Violators will be towed at the owner's expense.
3. Smoking is not permitted in any building.
4. No grooming in any buildings on the fairgrounds. Please pick up piles of hair and dispose of properly.
5. Dogs may not be left in the grooming tents overnight. All crates should be marked with a contact name and phone number at all times.
6. No ex-pens or crates are allowed on blacktop surfaces or adjacent to the Expo Center. A day-crating tent is available (without power) near the grooming tents.
7. No flexi-leads allowed in the Expo Center or the Stock Arena.
8. Loud noise, abusive language, large parties, hazardous activities, and other annoyances will not be allowed. Trash must be disposed of in a proper container.
9. No parking in fire lane.
10. Personally rented golf carts must be parked at your RV site or in designated parking areas.
11. Any rude or obscene behavior towards the Monroe County Fair Board or Staff could lead to removal of the grounds.
12. If your child is in a stroller, keep a respectful distance from dogs, particularly dogs whose heads are at the same level as your child. Be very careful when near dogs so that you don't run over tails or feet or bump into them. Be sure your child does not reach out to touch a dog without owner's permission.
13. If it is necessary to rescue a dog on the show grounds or from a vehicle, neither the Clubs (GRCA and/or CVGRC) nor Monroe County Fairgrounds will be responsible or liable for any damage to the vehicle involved. Injured and/or ill dogs will be examined and treated by a veterinarian at the owner's expense.

MONROE COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS CAMPING RULES

14. RV's and trailers are permitted in designated areas only.
15. Camping member responsible must be of at least 18 years of age and no one under the age of 18 is permitted to reside on a campsite without adult supervision.
16. A camping permit sticker will be provided upon check-in and shall be displayed on your unit in a prominent location visible from the roadway. This must be displayed at the time of parking your camper.
17. Your camping unit shall be located on your designated space. Your unit shall not protrude into the adjacent camping space (including awnings). If you are uncertain of your placement do not unhook until contacting the Directors in Charge.
18. Quiet time starts at 11:00pm.
19. Campfires are not allowed on the fairgrounds.
20. No generators are allowed except for primitive camping.
21. Generator Rules: Keep generators as far from all campsites as possible. Do not leave generators running unattended.
22. Absolutely no sub-leasing of your campsite. Campsites are for individuals/vendors who requested and were approved for camping by the Directors in Charge.
23. Any violations of these rules in the judgment of the Directors in Charge will be grounds for the removal of you, your camping unit and any other persons using your unit from the grounds. No fees will be refunded.
24. All debris must be removed from your campsite following the show. Campsite must be in the same condition as when you moved onto your campsite. If site is not clean you will be charged for trash removal.
25. There will be no generators allowed on the grounds except in the East parking lot (outside the fence).

PLEASE keep your camping area neat and tidy!

TRANSFER OF ENTRIES

NOTE: TRANSFER OF ENTRIES AND REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS FOR PUBLISHED JUDGE CHANGES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE AFTER 12:00 NOON ON MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 5. AFTER THIS TIME, YOU MUST CONTACT THE SUPERINTENDENT ON SITE.

CONFORMATION: Dogs may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is presented to the Superintendent at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP: Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent prior to the start of the class at the show. Correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer must be made to the Superintendent prior to the judging of the class at the show.

OBEDIENCE OR RALLY: A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class; or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible provided the club offers transfers. Transfers from an "A" to "B" class at the same level are allowed provided the host club allows transfers. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Superintendent or Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Clubs may choose to accept transfers prior to the day of the trial and this should be clearly stated in the premium list. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companionship. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
